


Print South West 25th May 2022 – 19th October 2022

There are of course printmakers working in other counties in the South West not included here The intention however has been to give a flavour and a snap shot of the art form both geographically and in the range of print processes at play.

In terms of print process, here we have – linocut, monotype, screenprint, letterpress, etching, photogravure, drypoint.

Printmaking is a broad, versatile, exacting and accessible art form. It is easy to make prints that impress even if you are someone who has little confidence or experience in art. Equally, there are many artists who specialise in print for a lifetime.
