All workshops are held on site and led by professional artists and specialists.

'FLIGHT II' showcases paintings and drawings created by a broad cross-section of Musgrove Park Hospital staff.

The artworks here were created in 5 x 2-hour evening workshops run for staff in November and December 2018. Under the guidance of professional artist, Sara Dudman RWA, the staff learnt techniques for using charcoal to create drawings which express movement and the essence of birds in flight. Following the drawings, the staff created acrylic paintings on canvas, responding to Sara's paintings in the accompanying exhibition 'FLIGHT' in The Musgrove Gallery.
